

**RESOLUTION NO. 2021-23-02**

**A RESOLUTION RENEWING AND EXTENDING THE MAYORAL DECLARATION OF DISASTER DUE TO SEVERE WINTER WEATHER EXECUTED ON FEBRUARY 16, 2021, BY MAYOR ERIC J. MARTINEZ, PURSUANT TO §418.108, TEXAS GOVERNMENT CODE.**

**WHEREAS**, on the 16<sup>TH</sup> Day of February 2021 Eric J. Martinez, Mayor of Brackettville, executed a Declaration of Disaster due to severe winter weather, in order to activate the appropriate recovery and rehabilitation aspects of all applicable local or interjurisdictional emergency management plans and authorize the furnishing of assistance under said declaration; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council finds it necessary and appropriate and in the public interest and for the public good to renew and extend the Mayoral Disaster Declaration in order to continue with the extraordinary protective measures and efforts afforded by said Disaster Declaration;


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRACKETTVILLE, TEXAS, as follows:**

**SECTION 1.** Pursuant to § 418.108 of the Texas Government Code, the Mayoral Declaration of Disaster executed by Mayor Eric J. Martinez on February 16, 2021, is hereby renewed, and extended, and shall continue to be in full force and effect until the City of Brackettville deems it unnecessary to continue.

**SECTION 2.** The City Administrator is hereby directed to distribute Resolution No. 2021-23-02 to any person or agency for the purposes intended.
